

Olympic Park Regulations for outdoor facilities

Visitors must behave in such a way within the outdoor areas of the Olympic Park that no other person is endangered, harmed or inconvenienced or disturbed to a greater extent than is unavoidable under the circumstances. When using sports equipment (bicycles, skates, etc.), particular consideration must be shown to other visitors; during events, the use of such sports equipment is forbidden for visitors within the event area.

By entering the park grounds managed by OLYMPIAPARK MÜNCHEN GMBH, the user accepts the following rules of conduct.

In particular, the following things are not allowed:

1. Driving or parking motor vehicles, including motorised two-wheelers (also scooters) on the paths and parking areas, and cycling on the lawns
2. Climbing trees, structures or other facilities outside of guided tours
3. Flying motorised model aircraft and other model aircraft (e.g. drones)
4. Operating electric vehicles that are larger than 1:18 scale and have a top speed of more than 10 km/h
5. Operating model cars with combustion engines
6. Swimming in the Olympic Lake, using the lake for recreational activities (e.g. boats, SUP, model boats) and walking on or using the ice
7. Feeding doves, water birds and fishes
8. Allowing dogs to run free on sports fields and in playground areas
9. Spending the night and camping
10. Lighting open fires
11. Possession or consumption of drugs as defined by the Narcotics Act
12. Trading or commercial activities of any kind, organising collections or gatherings, begging
13. Damaging, defacing or placing stickers on facilities or equipment, including the distribution of leaflets and other items, as well as discarding or leaving dog waste
14. Taking photographs and filming for commercial purposes
15. Entering restricted areas
16. Sledging and skiing

Exceptional permits are issued by OLYMPIAPARK MÜNCHEN GMBH.

Using the outdoor facilities happens at your own risk. In particular, no liability is accepted for cases of slight negligence, except in the event of injury to life, limb or health.

In the event of any breaches, in addition to being asked to leave the premises or being banned from entering, claims for compensation may be made or the offence may be prosecuted under criminal law. The Olympiapark Regulations of the City of Munich apply to the buildings.
